## Homework Club

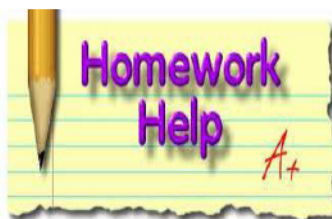
Are you looking for extra Homework help / study support for your children?
