Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the school year! What an exciting start for the children. The school has been redecorated throughout and the new building is now open. The children now have a better quality learning environment and space, which they have been really enjoying. Lots of you have made some really positive comments too, so thank you. I know you'd like me to share with you how hard the teachers have worked over the Summer to get the school ready for the children. We only had access to the new classrooms in the last week of the Summer holidays, so it has been all hands on deck!

You should all now know that there had to be a few practical changes to the dropping off and picking up arrangements. We sent out texts and have had staff posted in strategic places to share information. But for those of you who are still not sure, here is what we now do:

Faunce Street gate is now NOT ALLOWED to be used as a main entrance. This is because when Southwark got planning permission some years ago for the new building, one of the conditions was that this entrance would no longer be used to relieve traffic congestion for residents. It will be open for Breakfast Club, for late children and for visitors to the office during the school day.

Where can I come in to drop off or collect my child?

There are two school entrances

Doddington Grove and **Gaza Street** (off Braganza Street))

Both gates open at 8.45 until 9.10 and then open at 3.15 until 3.45

Where is After School Club?

This is now in the new building and you collect your child from the entrance in **Sharsted Street** (this is the only time when this entrance can be used)

Thank you for stepping away from the lines so promptly on Thursday and Friday. This made it easier and safer to take the children in. Doing this every day is really important.
