Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all of you who responded to our Autumn Term Survey. 120 of you replied, that's about one third of the school. That's a very good response and gives the school a representative sample, which is really useful.

We sent out the survey because we wanted to find out what you think about some of the changes and improvements the school has been making to behaviour, homework, communication and pupil progress.

Here is a summary of what you told us:

Behaviour

That's really pleasing, as the pupils also enjoy this aspect of homework the most. More good news is that standards in maths and writing are improving across the school, so your support at home with all homework must be helping too.
