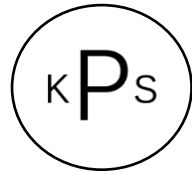

 Don't forget to log onto Mathletics!

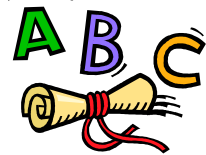
READING
