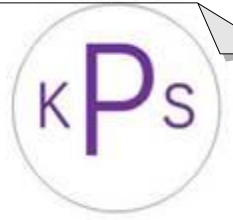


"Splash" Homework

READING

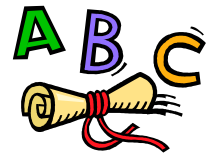


Remember to read each day and get an adult to sign your reading card /book.
