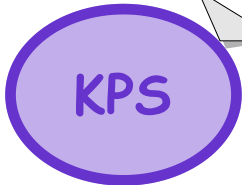

Remember to revise your weekly number facts to earn your reward based on your rocket card!

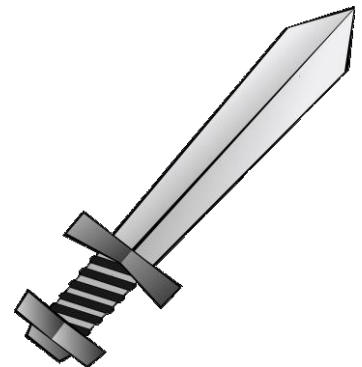
Children will be tested each week on their number facts - they will be told which ones to learn by their teacher. Prizes will be awarded in assembly to children who are successful.
