1. Label a picture of a bus and use adjectives or adverbs to describe it. E.g. *fast wheels, misty windows, shiny steering wheel*
2. Write a letter to a bus driver asking him about his job and what his favourite part is. Remember to use a question mark.
3. Describe a route for a bus to take from your house to get somewhere e.g. 1st take a right hand turn 2nd go forwards 3rd stop at the traffic lights.

NOW CHOOSE SOME OR ALL OF THESE:

1. Create your own bus, maybe it could even have passengers.
2. Create a map, maybe it could even have road signs and labels.
