

Pay attention to the different ways he is feeling throughout the book.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Ih0iu80u04Y</p> <p>Discuss:</p> <p>Do you agree with the colours he uses for each emotion? Would you change any?</p> <p>Have you felt any of these emotions recently? When did you feel that way?</p> <p>If you are feeling sad, what things do you do to make yourself feel better?</p> 	<p>Task #1</p> <p>In the story, the colour monster feels lots of different emotions. Can you write down the name of each emotion and how they make the monster feel? E.g. <i>Happiness makes the monster feel bright and light.</i></p>  <p>Task #2</p> <p>Can you think of an emotion that is not mentioned in the book and show this emotion in the empty jar? Use pictures and colours that you think represent that feeling.</p> <p>(Ideas for other emotions - excited, worried, proud, bored, surprised).</p>



What made you feel confused?


What can you do if you are feeling confused to make you feel better?

Task – create a poster offering advice on what to do when you are feeling confused.

The heading of your poster is **What to do when you feel confused.**

In your poster you must include:

- modal verbs (can, could, may, might, must, should, will, would) when offering advice.
- a question and question mark.

Are you feeling a bit confused?
