Dear Parents and Carers,

It's so we can have a picture of your views of the school as a whole, rather than the individual things we may talk about all through the year. It is also for those parents who either don't bring their children themselves or who have to drop and run and don't have a chance to pass on their thoughts. It's also the opportunity for you to share an idea or thought that you've meant to, but not found the right time.

Once the deadline is passed I look through them all and analyse the responses. I'll then report to you, the children, the governors and the staff what has been shown. I will also share with you how we will address any suggestions or comments raised.

I know how busy life is, but if you can find 5 minutes to complete the survey we would be so grateful. Working in partnership with you is at the heart of what we do.

Your child would have bought home a letter last week regarding updating your contact details for our records.

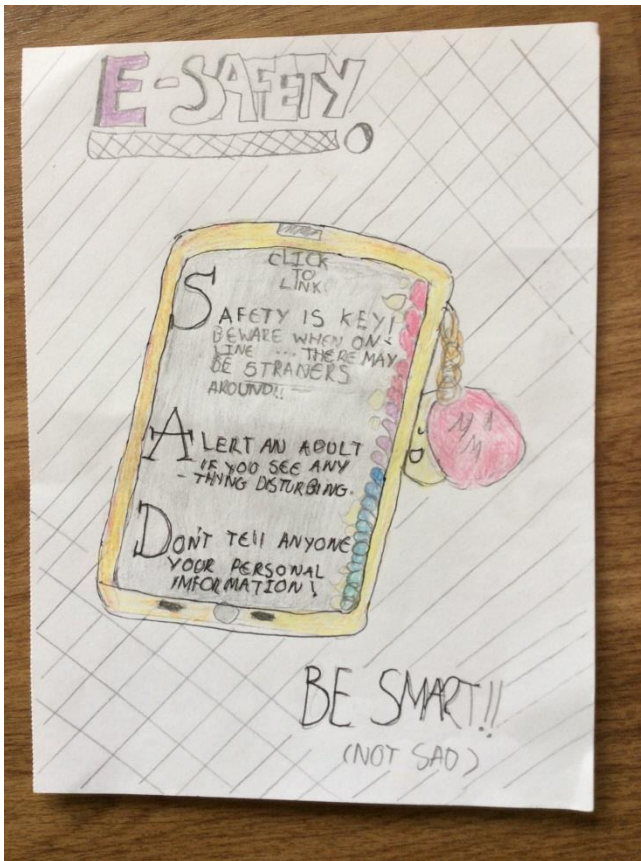
Thank you to all those who have already handed the letter back to the office.
