Dear Parents and Carers,

It is with great sadness that I write to you this week. Sadly, one of our Keyworth families have suffered the tragic loss of a much loved teenaged son. The school has sent its condolences to the family and spoke with them yesterday. This tragedy is in the public arena and therefore the school has sought advice and guidance on how to best support the school community in dealing with this sad, sensitive and complex matter.

We have put in place additional PSHE assemblies, additional nurture sessions and one to one sessions as necessary. The staff have been given advice and guidance about how to deal with questions from pupils as they arise in an age appropriate manner. The school will need to continue to offer appropriate support and care and will make use of outside agencies as necessary. We will be putting the text of assemblies on the website and useful links which may be helpful for you should your child wish to talk about it at home.

The loss of a child brings unimaginable heartache and we will be working closely with the family to offer support and care in the immediate future and on an ongoing basis. There is no one approach and as a school we will be adapting to meet the emerging needs of our pupils.

Thank you all on behalf of myself and the staff for immense kindness, wisdom and support shown this week. I am sure you will join us in sending our heartfelt condolences to this Keyworth family at this terrible time.

The family has organised a Fun Day for the community on Saturday 12th May at the Jack Hobbs Community Centre.
