Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the new school year! It was so good to see our families and pupils looking refreshed and well rested after a beautiful Summer. Look out for Curriculum Class letters in book bags today.

As this is the first Newsletter of the school year here is some useful information, reminders and changes to school routines.

### **What time does school start?**

The bell for the start of school goes at 8.55 a.m. The children line up and go into class. A second bell is rung shortly after. This is the signal for children to line up silently and parents who are still in the playground that it is time to leave, as the gates will be locked at 9.05 a.m. promptly. Punctuality is key for a settled start to school and a key life skill and children who are late 3 times in a half term will receive a detention.

### **Where can I come in to drop off or collect my child?**

There are **two** school entrances for dropping off and collecting at the beginning and the end of the school day

**Doddington Grove** and **Gaza Street** (off Braganza Street))

Both gates open at 8.45 a.m. and are locked at 9.05 a.m. They open again at 3.15 p.m. until 3.45 p.m.

**Faunce Street** gate is **NOT ALLOWED** to be used for parents dropping off or collecting children.

**It is for Breakfast Club children, for children who arrive late (after the other gates are locked) and for visitors/parents to the office during the school day.** This is a Southwark agreement with Faunce Street residents to relieve congestion. The exception to this is the small number of families who live in Faunce Street. If you attempt to use this entrance outside of these parameters, you will be denied access and directed elsewhere.

### **What time is Breakfast Club?**

Breakfast Club is open from 8.00 a.m. to 8.35 a.m. Children are given breakfast and are supervised by school staff until they are taken to line up with their classes at the beginning of the day. There is a charge of £1 per session. You do not need to book in advance.

### **Where is After School Club?**

This is in the new building and you collect your child from the entrance in **Sharsted Street** (this is the only time when this entrance can be used). You need to pre book. Contact the office if you wish to book a place, or to find out about costs.
