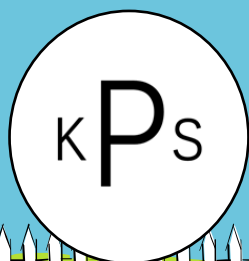
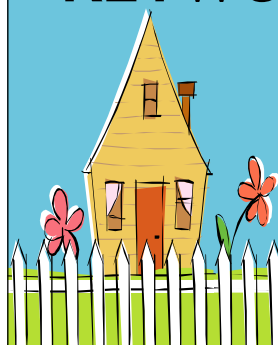

Please see the latest updates / information below:

## Punctuality to school

A reminder that school starts at **8:55am**. Children need to be in school when they bell goes at this time. If a child is late 3 times, they will receive a detention. We will be closing Doddington Gate and Gaza Gate by 9:05am.

## Meetings with school staff

If you would like to arrange a meeting with your child's class teacher, you can do so by contacting the school office. Please do not try to speak to a class teacher at 8:55am as teachers need to get children into the classroom to start their learning. You should, where possible, meet with your child's class teacher before meeting with any of the Senior Leaders in relation to your child. For your reference, the Senior Leaders in charge of each of the year groups are as follows: Jaime (Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2), Chontel (Years 3 and 4), Ray (Year 5) and Miri (Year 6).

## Term time absence

If you wish to request for your child to be absent from school, you need to complete an *Absence Request Form* that can be collected from the school office. Please note that the Southwark guidelines have changed for what absence we can authorise so please do not be offended if we are unable to authorise absence from school. Only absence in 'exceptional circumstances' can now be authorised.
