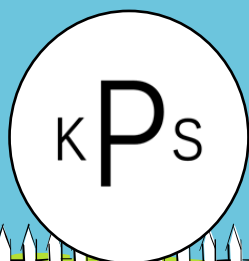
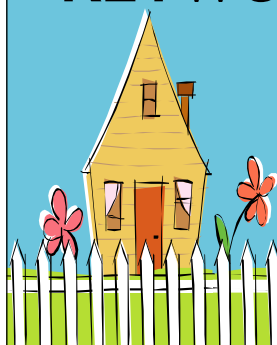

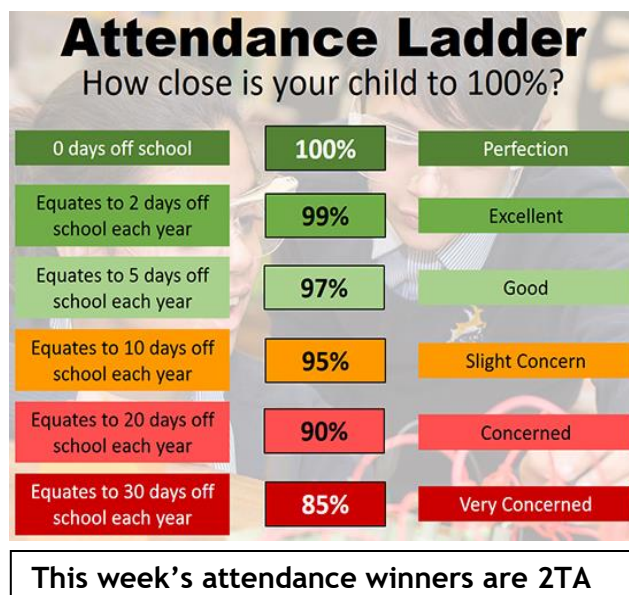
## Attendance
