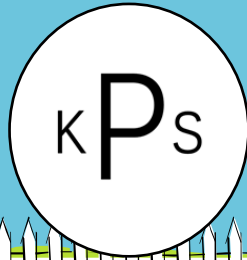
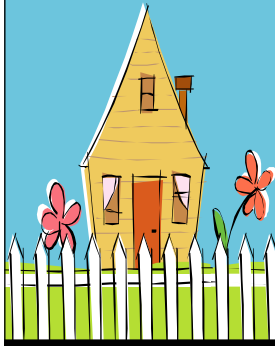

Tutorial Day

Tutorial Day will take place on **Monday 9th November** and is an opportunity for parents/carers to talk with their child's teacher to discuss how their child is doing in school. From Friday 16th October, those who have booked an appointment will receive a link to the zoom meeting. This will need to be kept safe so you can access the meeting on the day.

A reminder that if you ever need to contact your child's teacher as you have a question or query, you can do so by emailing/calling the school office. Please try not to speak to staff in detail at the school gate as we want to keep everyone safe and socially/physically distant.
