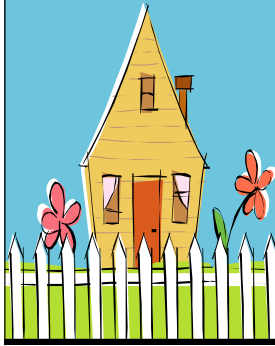

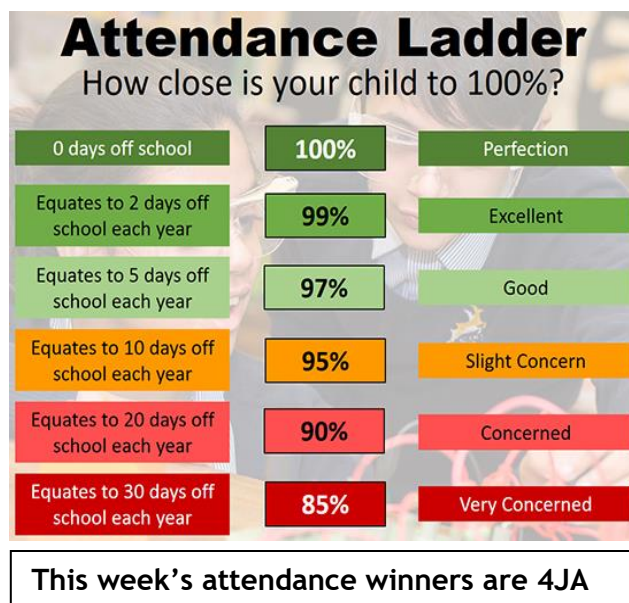
Attendance

Tutorial day

Doddington Grove works - pavements

We have been informed by Southwark Council that they will be undertaking extensive works to improve the pavements on Doddington Grove from **10th May through to 14th August**. This will mean that there will be footpath closures with pedestrian diversions and parking suspensions. We have been advised that families will still be able to access the school via Doddington gate as the works around this school entrance will be completed during the next half-term.

Times Tables Rock Stars - KS2

By the end of year 4 it is expected that children can recall all of their times tables through to 12x12. By the end of KS2 they are expected to recall all times table facts almost instantly (within a couple of seconds). This is a reminder that in school we are promoting the use of *Times Tables Rock Stars*. Every child in KS2 has their own personalised login details and we would ask that they practise their times tables at home as much as possible.
