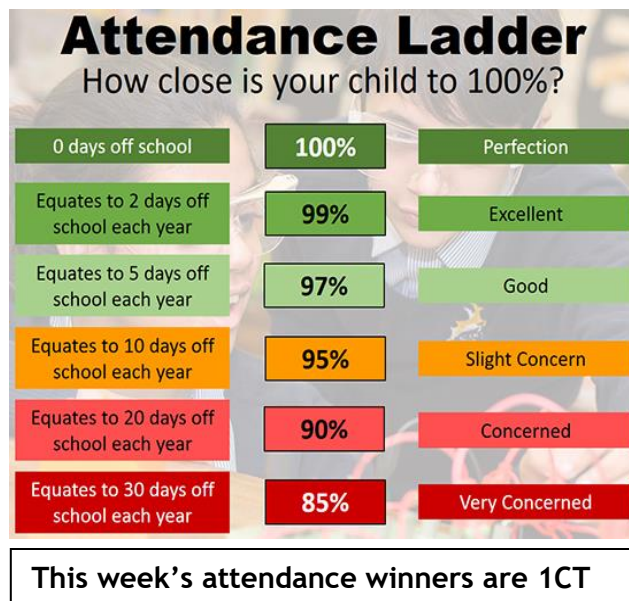
## Attendance

### Festival of Sport - activities

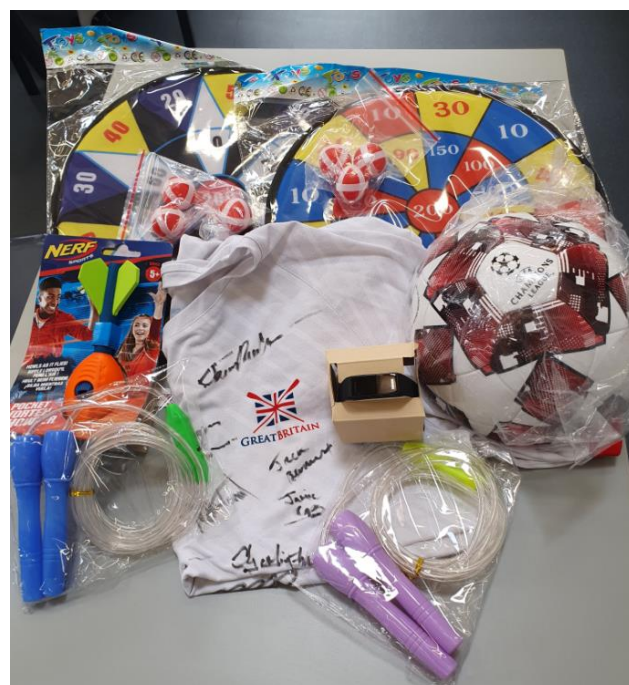
