

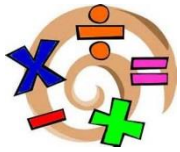
YEAR 4 CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER SUMMER 2

Topic- Our topic for this term is 'Social and Environmental Activism'. We will be learning about activists who work hard to make positive changes in the world. Please make sure your child is completing their topic homework which can be found in the green topic books.



English - This term in English, we will be developing our writing skills through looking at a variety of different texts, including a range of fiction and non-fiction. Our main text for the first few weeks will be 'Grandpa Chatterji's Indian Summer'. In spelling we will be learning suffixes, prefixes and apostrophes for contractions and we will be consolidating these through handwriting (letter join). During guided reading, we will be exploring a range of fiction and non-fiction.



Maths-We will be looking at Fractions for the first few weeks of the half term. We will then move on to Decimals/geometry closer to the holidays. Your child will continue to have a rocket test each Friday. If they complete the test successfully, they will move up the rocket. They should practice the skill for the test they're on as their homework.



Science- In science we will be consolidating our learning and working on our scientific skills. They will develop skills in knowledge, reasoning and classifying.

PE- Your child will have two PE sessions per week. 4JA will continue to have P.E on Tuesdays and Thursdays. 4MV will continue to have P.E on Mondays and Fridays. Unfortunately, due to the current circumstances, swimming will not be possible in this half term.
