
Attendance

End of year evaluation

Recently, Keyworth had an end of year evaluation which was carried out by Southwark Council. When schools are inspected, they are graded either Outstanding, Good, Requires Improvement or Inadequate. Keyworth was reviewed as follows:

Obviously, we are delighted with the feedback overall but will continue to work hard to improve the school going forward. We do need your help though - please continue to support the school by ensuring that your child/ren come/s to school every day and on time. For Keyworth to have outstanding attendance, we need a school average of over 96% each week. In recent weeks, Keyworth's attendance has fallen significantly short of this total.

End of the school day

If parents/carers provide their child/ren with permission to go home alone, the children are no longer the school's responsibility in terms of supervision when outside of school. Senior leaders have witnessed groups of children just hanging about which we discourage and there have been several incidents that the school has had to investigate as a result of this. Please help us by telling your child/ren to go straight home after school and remind them of the expectations in terms of their behaviour when travelling to and from school.
