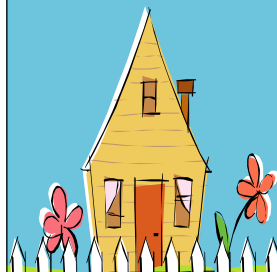

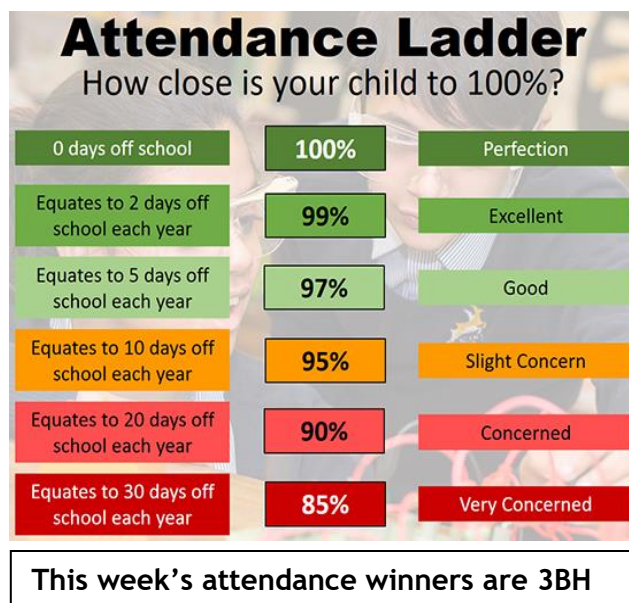
## Attendance

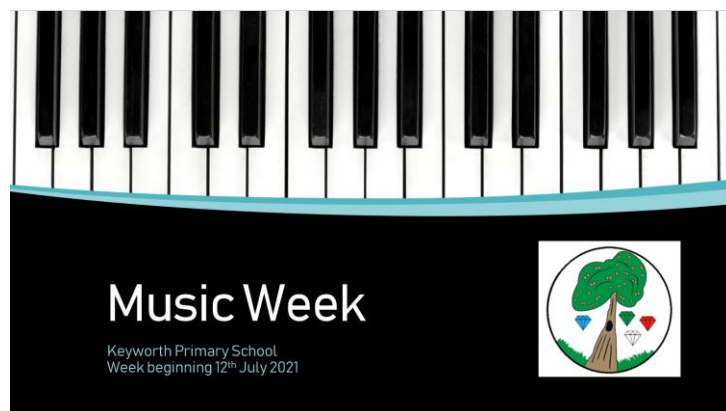

### Festival of Music

Next week in school we will be hosting our *Festival of Music*, which has been organised by Jaime. Every day, the children will be engaging in musical themed activities and events. The details are as follows:

- At the start of the week the children will be creating a musical concept map, showing what musical knowledge they already have. At the end of the week, this will be updated with any new information that they have learned.
- Every day they will be taught a lesson around the themes of listening and appraising; musical instrument focus; body percussion, an artist focus and music around the world.



- Every class will also take part in a body percussion workshop, delivered by a music specialist.
